Meeting Minutes: December 9, 2019

Call to Order: Sue Deyo, President, called the meeting to order at 6:20pm.

Welcome/Devotion/Prayer: Sue welcomed each of the visitors by name. She then offered the devotion and Betty Jeffreys gave the prayer.

Ratification of November 2019 Minutes: Sue Deyo announced that the Board of Directors voted to suspend the ratification of minutes and all old business until the January meeting.

The meeting was suspended at 6:30pm for dinner.

The meeting reconvened at 7:10pm.

Town Proclamation: Sue Deyo asked Hilliard Town Council President John Beasley to come up to the podium. Mr. Beasley read a Town of Hilliard proclamation that made December 9, 2019 "Country Star Quilt Guild Day." He presented a formal stamped and signed proclamation to Sue for the Guild's records. Opportunity Quilt: Bonnie Cranmer Eisenhower announced that as of that date, \$3,665.23 were raised. She also announced that the guild member who distributed the largest number of tickets was Ramona Lee, who handled around 600 tickets. Sue asked Marsa Detscher to present Ramona with the promised gift. Marsa explained that 9 blocks that remained from the quilt were made into a small quilt; the label reads "Country Star Quilt Guild thanks Ramona Lee, Top Sales 2019."

Sue Deyo asked John Beasley to return to the podium and draw the winning ticket from a pillowcase containing all the ticket slips. The ticket with the name Ben Johnson of Fernandina Beach was drawn.

Sue asked Pamela Nelson from The Nest to some up and talk about the organization. Ms. Nelson talked about the organization and acknowledged the packages of diapers, blankets, and burp cloths that the Guild collected and made for The Nest.

Anniversary: Sue Deyo invited all founding Executive Board members present at the meeting to come to the front of the room. She thanked them all, and Chris Sandstrom in particular, for their foresight, drive, and vision. Sue advised that 27 of the original 55 members were dues-paying members today. She asked all of these 27 members present to come to the front. She gave each a small bag containing a custom-made lapel pin depicting the Country Star Quilt Guild logo.

December Birthdays: Sue Deyo invited all those with December birthdays to come up front and everyone sang "Happy Birthday." Each selected a mug rug.

Show and Tell: Members showed off their beautiful projects.

BOM: Lori Frederick and Linda Greene commended all those who brought their block of the month. They announced the colors for the January meeting: Red, Green, and Gray/Silver. The exact colors are posted on the Facebook page. They gave a prize to the quilter with the winning ticket.
